



Tournament Format

4 Player Scramble

Registered teams will be grouped according to team skill level – competitive, recreational, or co-ed.

Each player hits off the tee. Your team selects the best shot and each player then hits from within one club length of the best ball. This continues until your team reaches the green, at which time all players putt from the same location of the best ball until the hole is completed.

Team prizes will be awarded to those finishing in first and second place of each division.

Players will have the opportunity to purchase mulligans, putting string and the Pro's drive in order to remain competitive.

Individuals will have opportunities to win special prizes by participating in various contests at specific holes, such as a chance to win cash at the Las Vegas Hole.

Where the Money Goes

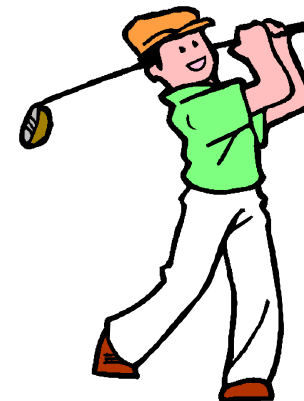

Our program is designed to enhance the emotional, social, intellectual, and physical development of your child and make a positive difference in his/her life.

CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) – Today, approximately 780,000 children in the US are caught up in the court and child welfare maze because they are unable to live safely at home. Imagine what it would be like to lose your parents, not because of something you did, but because they can't—or won't—take care of you. Now, into these children's lives come dozens of strangers: police, foster parents, therapists, social workers, judges, lawyers, and more. Hopefully, one of these strangers is a CASA volunteer.

CASA volunteers are appointed by judges to watch over and advocate for abused and neglected children, to make sure they don't get lost in the overburdened legal and social service system or languish in an inappropriate group or foster home. They stay with each case until it is closed, and the child is placed in a safe, permanent home. For many abused children, their CASA volunteer will be the one constant adult presence—the one adult who cares only for them.

CASA volunteers have helped more than two million abused children since the first program was established in 1977.
